1 10/20/07 Saturday	BF5 HORSESHOE MESA Campsite	EPA drinking water standards are for municipal water and based on consistent daily consumption. No standards have been set for occasional use. While limited sampling indicates the water in Miners/Page Spring may exceed these MUNICIPAL water standards for arsenic, the dehydration threats from not drinking can be much more immediate and life threatening. Camp in Designated Sites only (these are marked with a campsite sign). Beware of ravens raiding backpacks for food and opening zippers. Mines are closed to visitation. Mines, mine tailings, and mine materials harbor health and safety hazards. The closest water is at Page/Miners Spring.
2 10/21/07 Sunday	BG9 COTTONWOOD CREEK Use Area	Beware of ravens raiding backpacks.
3 10/22/07 Monday	BH9 GRAPEVINE Use Area	Beware of ravens raiding backpacks.
4 10/23/07 Tuesday	BJ9 CREMATION Use Area	Hikers may not camp anywhere West of the large trailside cairns (rockpiles). These cairns are knee to waist high and are on both sides of the trail (like a gate) approximately 3/4 miles east of the South Kaibab trail.
5 10/24/07 Wednesday	CBG BRIGHT ANGEL Campground	
6 10/25/07 Thursday	OUT Hiking Out
